

Immeasurably**MORE** captures the essence of what it means to be a faith-filled people seeking to believe and trust God for what's next. To love God whole-heartedly, to love people sacrificially, to assert everyone's welcome, and to declare it's all about Jesus. To echo the words of the Apostle Paul and affirm that we will become "All things to all people so that by all means we might save some and we do it all for the sake of the gospel"

(1 Corinthians 9:22-23). To truly believe that God is able to do immeasurably more than any of us could ask or imagine him doing!



Followers of Christ are meant to be world-changers. That's the life we were meant to live. The gospel creates purpose in us that brings lasting joy within and makes much of Jesus in the process. And we must radically live out that purpose in a world still in desperate need of Jesus. I believe the Holy Spirit is powerfully at work within and among us and there are many incredible years of ministry ahead together!

When we first met as a launch team back in 2015, there were about 30 people gathered in my family room. To be honest, we didn't know the first thing about starting a new church but we knew God was up to something so we kept courageously moving forward as he faithfully led us. Learning along the way, sometimes stumbling and falling, we opened the doors of All Church in January of 2016 and God has been ever faithful to our church since that day!

During those early days, the vision to be an authentic church that would strive to maintain a balance between biblical centrality and cultural relevance was already on my heart. I wanted to be a church where everyone could attend no matter what their habits or hang-ups were. I wanted to be a church where people could truly get a glimpse of the grace of God through the saving power of the gospel—a church where the Word was preached faithfully and applied to daily life regularly. The keys to the success of this vision are clarity, united church leadership, and a people who are committed to living it out. I have never felt more certain that these three ingredients are in place than I do right now, and I see a hopeful future emerging!

As I have reflected, however, there is one key ingredient that is significantly impairing our ability to fully realize this vision. Our current building has become a barrier. We need a building that will reflect our heart for people, more intentionally promote our worship and time in the Word, and be an ever-burning light for Jesus in our community. Our current building was never designed to be a long-term house for our church. Yes, we manage to reach over 600 people each week at 5699 Creek Road, but it is not a viable option for future growth. Our current worship auditorium wasn't originally designed for worship. Our lobby wasn't designed for community or welcoming new guests. Our next generation ministries need new, strategic spaces to better serve kids and students each week. These are profound challenges. But they are not insurmountable. In fact, addressing them together could become the adventure of a lifetime! That's what I'm calling us into.

Our ImmeasurablyMORE project offers real, creative architectural solutions that position All Church for the next chapter of our ministry. The creation of a brand-new lobby will put relationships, community life, and equipping at the center of our life together. The creation of a new worship auditorium will give the beauty of the gospel and the glory of God a home specifically designed to enhance the quality of our worship. The creation of brand-new AC Kids and student spaces will foster new opportunities for kids and students alike to meet Jesus and continue learning about and following him. ImmeasurablyMORE puts these central priorities of All Church front and center, creating for us a fresh catalyst for ministry.

God has blessed the vision, courage and faithfulness of people who believed in what All Church could be six years ago. I believe with all my heart he intends to continue this in us as we step forward in faith together. We are stewards of the gospel and the mission of King Jesus in the city of Cincinnati and beyond. Please join me in taking full advantage of what God is leading us to do. Join me in prayer that God would make us wise and bold as we step out into this next chapter of our life together. I stand on tiptoe to see how God will transform us as he does ImmeasurablyMORE within us.













**Phase 1

Because we all have unique giving capabilities, we can't simply divide the total needed by the number of families in our church to determine an average gift. The following is a model of the distribution of gifts it will take for us to be successful. This also underscores the biblical principle of giving in proportion to what we have and that's going to be different for all of us.
